Extended Utilization Payments can be made up to 60 days from the time the inspection is due.

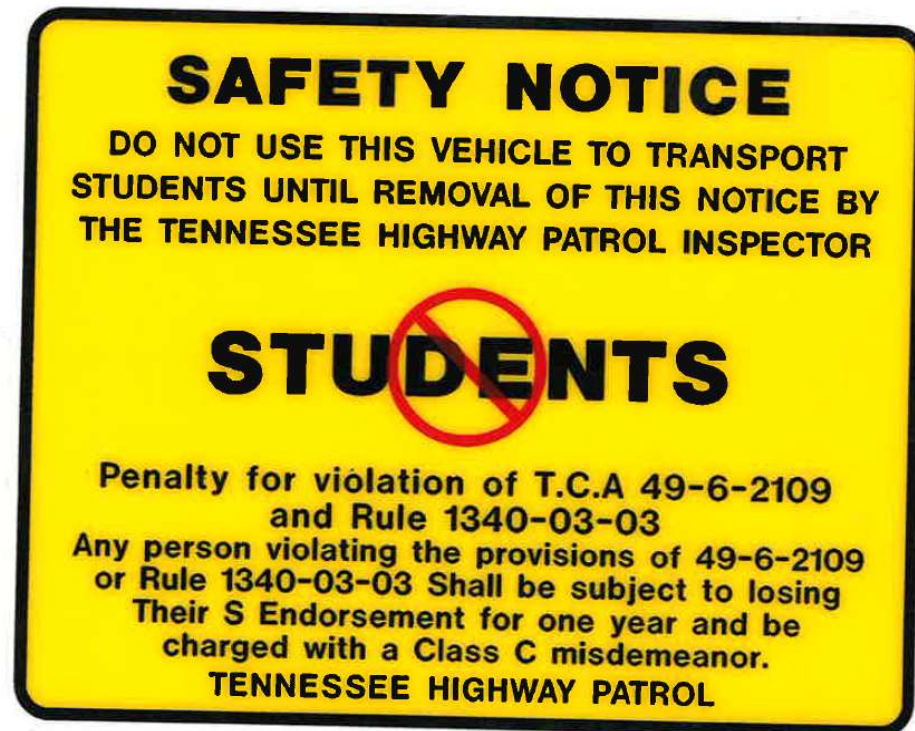
DMV (Drivers Licenses Stations):

If a driver has to do anything with there CDL make sure the take : current 2C form, Infnit-I training certificate, 2 proofs of residency (medical card is electronic starting June 15th)

If a driver or contractor contacts Pupil transportation, they need to be nice to the office staff. They will assist the best they can however we do not do anything with the medical card, if the driver leaves the DMV without verifying the information on their license, then that is their fault. Once they leave, they own the problem.

This goes for completing annual training as well. If the driver fails to complete the annual training in the assigned training month how is that anyones fault but the driver??? If the driver provide an e-mail or cell phone number, they will get notified on the first day of the training month. Second, we notify the transportation directors of anyone we have in their group that has not completed the training by mid month. National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners (National Registry), Known as NR2

National Registry of Certified Medical Examiner (NR2) final rule, a follow-on rule to the National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners (National Registry), thereby improving safety on your Nation's roadways.

NR2 final rule is to facilitate the electronic transmission of examination results (medically qualified, medically unqualified, and voided) and additional information (e.g., corrective lenses, hearing aid, medical exemption, skill performance evaluation certificate, etc.) from examinations performed for commercial learner's permit / commercial driver's license applicants/holders from FMCSA's National Registry to the State Driver's Licensing Agencies to be posted on the Commercial Driver's License Information System driver motor vehicle record.

When must impacted individuals comply?

By June 23, 2025. However, FMCSA will allow states to implement NR2 before June 23, 2025, if they are ready to do so. **TN will implement on June 15th, 2025.** When states implement NR2, medical certification information for CLP applicants and CDL holders in those states will be electronically transmitted from the National Registry to the TN and the original/paper Medical Examiner's Certificate, Form MCSA-5876, may no longer be used as proof of medical certification. In states that have implemented NR2, the medical examiner is not required to issue the original/paper Medical Examiner's Certificate, Form MCSA-5876, as the medical certification information will be electronically transmitted to TN.

National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners (National Registry), Known as NR2

- **Law Enforcement Officers**

- Must use only the electronic results transmitted to TN Driver license System and posted to the CDLIS driver MVR as official proof of medical certification for drivers.

- **How will NR2 improve highway safety?**

- NR2 improves the quality of driver medical certification information by replacing paper records with electronic records. FMCSA will now electronically transmit medical certification information from the National Registry to TN. NR2 also provides roadside inspectors and law enforcement officers with the most current medical certification information for these drivers. In addition, it eliminates the possibility of uncertified medical examiners issuing a Medical Examiner's Certificate, Form MCSA-5876, to CLP applicants and CDL holders as only certified medical examiners can report results of physical qualification examinations through the National Registry. As a result, NR2 ensures drivers are medically certified to operate in interstate commerce, improving highway safety.

- **Medical Variances**

In situations that a medical examiner indicates that the driver is required to obtain a medical variance (SPE Certificate or medical exemption) on the submitted examination result, the driver examination results will not be transmitted to TN until the driver have been issued the medical variance by FMCSA. Once the medical variance has been issued, the National Registry system will link it with the driver initial examination results and transmit the information to TN. **Please note that the driver is still required to carry medical variances documentation while operating.**

National Registry of Certified Medical Examiners (National Registry), Known as NR2

- The state of Tennessee will go live June 15th, 2025
- If the driver doesn't request a copy of the medical card, one will not be given
- No longer allowed to carry a copy to the DMV or upload to E-services
- Hard stop in A-list to only allow the S endorsement holders to hold a 1-year medical card even if the medical examiner gives the driver a 2-year card.
- If the driver goes over 1-year on the medical card a list will be generated, and the transportation directors will be notified.
- S Endorsement will be removed from the license and a letter will be generated.
